INTERACTIVE STUDY GUIDE FOR REACHING CHINESE AND EAST ASIANS

This worksheet is available to you individually or in a group setting. Jot down answers to questions and generate group activities as the Holy Spirit directs you. Bless you in your obedience to reach the unreached throughout the nations.

Chapter 1 - Religious Beliefs and Worldview

Discuss why it's important to have an understanding of the Traditional Chinese worldview in order to reach these people.

What challenges to evangelism do you foresee in a culture that values filial piety above all else?

Chapter 2 - God Revealed in Chinese History

Can you think of a testimony from your own life that demonstrates the attributes of God? Share this with the group and talk about how you could use this story in your conversation with Chinese people. What are ways you need to adapt your testimony to their worldview?

Chapter 3 - Evangelism Principles

Discuss some ways you can use principles from a Buddhist worldview as a starting point for conversing about Biblical principles.

Why is it so important to build relationships with individuals as we evangelize?

In your group, practice sharing the gospel using the concepts of honor and shame. Is this easy or difficult for you to use this terminology? Ask any people from an honor culture to share how new terms and ways of sharing made them feel.
